## Red Morton Park – Westside Renovation Project

### Project Background

Red Morton Park is located in central Redwood City and bordered by Valota Road, Madison Avenue and Vera Street. The park, which was assembled over decades, is approximately 32 acres. The park contains sports fields, playgrounds and several buildings including the administrative offices at the Community Activities Building (CAB) of the City's Parks Department.

### Project Area

The project area will include the playground and parking lot near Valota Road, the parking lot near the CAB, pathways and signage throughout the park for pedestrians and bicycles, and sports field viewing areas. The project also includes improvements to the main pedestrian entrance into the park from Valota Road and street crossings surrounding the park.

### Project Objectives

1. Improve circulation throughout the park – specifically: the connectivity between buildings (existing and future), fields, and other amenities including neighborhood entrances to park; the introduction of a north/south and east/west bike paths; and bike and pedestrian safety to and from streets that surround the park.
2. Build a Magical Bridge that is accessible to everyone to enjoy – Redwood City has partnered with the Magical Bridge Foundation to build an innovative and inclusive playground to open at Red Morton Park. 3. Improve sports field spectator areas– consider new amenities, improve bleachers, and seating areas that are comfortable, shaded places to watch field activities.
