Redwood Baptist Church, located at **2323 / 2325 Euclid Avenue**, has applied for a Use Permit for the addition of a K-12 school and child care facility at the subject property. The proposed use is allowable under the current zoning for that area (Section 5.4 of the City's Zoning Ordinance), contingent upon City approval of a Use Permit.

You and your neighbors are invited to attend the **FOLLOW-UP COMMUNITY MEETING** to get an update on the proposed project and ask questions. This meeting is scheduled for:

City staff will provide an update on the review process since the first community meeting held on November 29, 2007, including an overview of the proposed school and day care use, the City's permit review process, information on the traffic study completed for the project area, and information regarding the upcoming public hearing for the Use Permit application. Church staff will provide information on the changes that have been made to the project in response to neighborhood concerns, and there will be ample time to ask questions.

Your thoughts and input on this proposed application are very important and you are invited and encouraged to attend and participate! No decisions will be made at this meeting - it is for information and discussion only. There will be an additional opportunity for community comment during the public hearing for the Use Permit application, and a separate public notice will be sent to you regarding the date of the public hearing.
