The Suburban Retrofit planning technique, which modifies single-use suburban developments into mixed-use, sustainable environments, is one of the New Urbanists' pragmatic approaches to the environmentally and socially dysfunctional elements of suburban sprawl. Using several DPZ projects as case studies, this lecture introduces the concept of the suburban retrofit on all urban scales, including the regional scale, the neighborhood scale, and the scale of the block and street. Among the projects presented are the first strip shopping center retrofit, a retrofit of a shopping mall into a town center, and the transformation of an office park into a mixed-use urban core.
