SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire, and upon arrival found smoke emitting from the residence. Upon entering the building firefighters found smoke coming from the kitchen area of the house. They found a small fire on the stove, extending into the cabinets above. Firefighters gained entry into the cabinets, wall and adjoining bathroom. There they found the fire had spread and used a hose line to extinguish. They used their Thermal Imaging Camera to check for further extension. The fire was contained to the kitchen, wall area and the roof support members.

The fire was caused by a pot left unattended on the stove.
