SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire, and upon arrival found two pickup trucks on fire. The trucks were parked next to a building. The window on the building failed causing concern that the fire had entered the building. While firefighters extinguished the fire, entry was made into the building to check for any fire extension. They used their thermal imaging camera to check for hot spots. Finding two possible areas of extension the wall was opened up for inspection. Both sites were found clear. The fire was contained to the area of origin.

The cause is under investigation by the Fire Prevention Bureau and the San Mateo County Sheriffs Office.
