SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire, and upon arrival found a small fire burning on the exterior of the building. The window had failed causing the fire to spread inside the building. Police Officers had used a small ABC dry powder extinguisher to control the fire. Firefighters extinguished the remainder of the fire and entry was made into the building to check for any fire extension. They used their thermal imaging camera to check for hot spots. The fire was contained to the area of origin.

The cause is under investigation by the Redwood City Fire Prevention Bureau and the Police Department.
