SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire, and upon arrival black smoke coming from the rear of the garage. The fire was to the exterior of the garage but had extended into the garage through an eave vent. While firefighters extinguished the fire, entry was made into the residence to check for any further fire extension. They used their thermal imaging camera to check for hot spots. Finding only smoke in the residence, damage was kept to a minimum. The fire was contained to the area of origin and garage.

The cause is under investigation by the Fire Prevention Bureau.
