SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire. Before their arrival a deputy investigated and found heavy smoke conditions in the kitchen area. A heat smoke detector was also activated.

Upon firefighters arrival there was black smoke coming from the ventilators on the roof over the kitchen area. Firefighters made an aggressive attack and confined the fire to the area of origin. They used their thermal imaging camera to check for hot spots. A 2<sup>nd</sup> alarm was called and then released shortly before their arrival.

The cause is under investigation by the Fire Prevention Bureau.
