**SYNOPSIS OF ALARM:** Redwood City and Menlo Park Fire Fighters arrived on the scene of a Single family House to find a single car garage well involved in fire. Fire Fighters worked quickly to contain the fire to the garage and a portion of the kitchen in the home. Firefighters were also tasked with treating an adult male who was burned in the fire. The victim was treated by paramedic firefighters and transported to Stanford Hospital by AMR Ambulance Company. A second alarm was requested, bringing in additional fire units from Menlo Park, Woodside, and Redwood City as a precautionary measure.

The burn victim was believed to be working on his car in the garage when gasoline vapors were ignited by a nearby open flame in a clothes dryer. The extent of his injuries are unknown, but are not believed to be life threatening. The fire prevention bureau is conducting an investigation of the fire.

No firefighters were injured in this fire.
