SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Firefighters responded to a report of a roof collapse with workers trapped. Upon arrival they found the façade partially hanging from the building. The four workers were all out from under the collapsed material and were treated by firefighters. All patients were treated for head, neck and back injuries. Patients were taken to Stanford Hospital via ambulance.

It is unknown what caused the collapse. The investigation is being conducted by the Redwood City Building Department.
