Weather Advisory

The Redwood City Fire Department is advising that the current weather pattern for today might cause some moderate flooding in the low lying areas. Today at 12:31 P.M. the tide will crest, causing water run off from the hills area and standing water in the lower areas to back up and cause some flooding. It is advised in the lower areas of the City that are prone to flooding to move your cars to higher ground. There is a high wind advisory from the National Weather Bureau in affect which means you should be aware of falling debris from trees and such. It is recommended to check your drains and downspouts to ensure that they are clear from debris to prevent any backup.
