SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from the Woodside, Belmont-San Carlos, Foster City, and Menlo Park Fire Departments responded to a report of smoke coming from the front of the store at the above address. On arrival we found a well involved fire in the store with possible extension to the store next door. Fire units went to work immediately and the fire was controlled in 32 minutes with no injuries reported. The second alarm units were staged down the street in case they were needed. There was extensive damage to the store the fire started in and moderate smoke and water damage to the unit next door. Two persons were displaced from an apartment to the rear, and there was moderate smoke damage to their apartment. The cause of the fire is under investigation by the Fire Prevention Bureau

El Camino Real was closed in both the north and south bound directions as the fire was being extinguished.

Also cooperating with the control of the incident was Pacific Gas and Electric Company, The Redwood City Water Department, The Redwood City Police Department, American Medical Response, The Peninsula Fire Buffs, and San Mateo County Public Safety Communications.
