SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park and Belmont-San Carlos responded to a fire in the gas station. On arrival firefighters found a working fire in the Bagel shop at the station. The fire was quickly extinguished. The Bagel shop was completely destroyed and the two other shops at the station were moderately damaged from smoke and products of combustion. There were no persons in the businesses at the time of the fire. There was one minor hand injury reported by a Fire Captain. He was treated at the scene by Fire Department personnel.

The cause of the fire is under investigation by the Fire Prevention Bureau.

Cooperating in the control of the fire was the Redwood City Police Department and PG&E
