SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Fire units from Redwood City, Menlo Park, and Woodside Fire Departments worked together this evening to control a Fire that occurred in a single family home at 665 Alameda de Las Pulgas, near Jefferson Ave.

Upon their arrival, the Firefighters found the homeowner had used a garden hose to help control, but not extinguish the fire. The fire burned the wood siding of the home and extended into the attic area. Firefighters entered the home and removed a portion of the sheetrock ceiling and wall to expose the burned attic area and to check for any additional extension of fire. The fire was contained to the burned wood siding, and a small portion of the attic.

The cause of the fire was a Propane Bar-B Que that was too close the side of the house. A neighbor notified the occupants of the home that their house was on fire. The occupants were able to safely exit the home without injury.
