SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with 2 units from Woodside, 2 units from Belmont-San Carlos, one unit from Foster City and one unit from CALFIRE responded on a structure fire. On arrival we found smoke coming from the eaves of a large church under renovation. 2nd and 3rd alarms were struck due to the initial difficulty in locating the fire and the size of the building. The fire was extinguished by the fire crews and a nearby private school released students early to help avoid traffic congestion in the area. There were no injuries to occupants or firefighters.

Other cooperating agencies: Redwood City Police Department, San Mateo Sheriffs Office of Emergency Services, Peninsula Fire Buffs.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

Quick action by workers on the scene reporting the fire right away allowed fire crews to be able to control the fire in its early stages. Prompt and accurate reporting of fires allows the fire department to respond quickly and help protect the lives and property of the citizens of our community.
