SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with a unit from Menlo Park and one from Belmont-San Carlos responded on a structure fire. On arrival we found units number 2 to be involved with fire. The fire was quickly extinguished by the fire crews and a mother dog and five puppies were removed from the fire and turned over to a representative from the SCPA. Additionally in unit number 4 we found a smoking pot on the stove and subsequently removed it with no damage to the apartment. There were no injuries to occupants or firefighters. The building was able to be occupied by the tenants of the other uninvolved units. And the puppies appeared to be fine

Other cooperating agencies: San Mateo County Sheriffs Office, Peninsula Humane Society.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

Though no one was home at the time of this fire it is best to have working smoke detectors in your house. A properly placed and working smoke detector gives a family the best chance to get out of a fire alive. Please check your smoke detectors
