**SYNOPSIS OF ALARM:** Redwood City Fire Department responded with a single Engine Company to a “ RV on fire in the driveway” at 610 Broadway St. Redwood City Police arrived on the scene and reported “ motor home on fire next to the building”. San Mateo County Communications upgraded the response to a structure fire and dispatched an additional 4 Engines, 1 Truck, 2 Battalion Chiefs . Redwood City Fire Engine 11 arrived on the scene and reported a motor home and adjacent building on fire. Engine 11 deployed a 1 ¾” hose line to extinguish the motor home and adjacent building. Additional companies arrived on the scene and assisted in extinguishment and overhaul of the fire. The fire destroyed the motor home and did minor damage to the building,

No injuries were reported.

Fire Units from San Carlos-Belmont Fire Department and Menlo Park Fire Department also responded to this incident to assist Redwood City Fire Fighters.
