SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park Fire District responded to a reported structure fire at the address above. On arrival fire units found a kitchen fire that had involved the kitchen and was extending to the living room. All of the occupants were out of the house and accounted for so the firefighters immediately went to work extinguishing the fire. The fire was quickly knocked down and there was no extension of fire beyond the two rooms involved. There was smoke and water damage to the kitchen and living room and some smoke damage to the remainder of the house. The cause of the fire appears to be accidental in nature and is currently under investigation by the Bureau of Fire Prevention. No injuries were reported as a result of the fire. The residents were able to find a place to stay as the house is uninhabitable.

Other cooperating agencies: Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

The family was home at the time of the fire and the properly installed smoke detectors activated as designed. A properly placed and working smoke detector gives a family the best chance to get out of a fire alive. Please check your smoke detectors.
