SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park Fire District responded to a reported structure fire at the address above. On arrival we found an extinguished fire in the 3rd floor laundry room. Two police officers from the Redwood City Police Department had entered the building and assisted with the evacuation of the building. The 3rd floor of the building was charged with smoke and all of the residents were safely out of the building on our arrival, and the alarm system was ringing. There was moderate smoke damage to the laundry room and the adjacent hallway. No injuries were reported at the time of the fire.

Other cooperating agencies: Redwood City Police Department, Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

This building was occupied at the time of the fire and all occupants were notified by the alarm system. A properly placed and working smoke detector gives a family the best chance to get out of a fire alive. Please check your smoke detectors.
