SYNOPSIS OF ALARM:

Redwood City Firefighters along with Firefighters from Menlo Park Fire and Belmont / San Carlos Fire worked to extinguish a Fire in a Duplex at 337 Chestnut Street in Redwood City.

Upon dispatch, Firefighters could see a column of dark smoke as they responded from their Stations. Dispatchers advised responding units there they were receiving multiple 911 calls regarding the fire.

Upon arrival, Firefighters found smoke and flames visible from the front of the dwelling. The occupants advised that everyone was out of the home. Firefighters worked aggressively to extinguish the Fire, and to conduct primary and secondary searches of both sides of the duplex. The Fire was confined primarily to a laundry room, with smoke and heat damage throughout one side of the duplex. Damage from the fire is estimated to be \$50,000 to the structure and \$15,000 to the contents. The Red Cross is providing temporary shelter to the 2 residents displaced by the fire.

There were no injures to Civilians or Firefighters.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation.
