**SYNOPSIS OF ALARM:** Redwood City Firefighters, along with Firefighters from Belmont-San Carlos and CalFire responded on a report of an unknown fire. On arrival we found a well involved fire in the rear of the house extending to the outside. A quick Search was done and no one was found in the home, trapped by the fire! The fire was extinguished and there was no extension of fire to the attic. Three adults were displaced by the fire and the Red Cross was called to assist with their housing.

Cooperating agencies: Redwood City Police Department, The Red Cross, American Medical Response, and Pacific Gas and Electric.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

A properly placed and working smoke detector gives a family the best chance to get out of a fire alive. Please check your smoke detectors at least twice a year!
