SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: At 1:11PM, Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park Fire Protection District and Belmont San Carlos Fire Department responded to a structure fire. Upon arrival, units found a fire in the detached garages behind the multi family residence at the address. The fire was extinguished by the fire crews and damaged was limited to four garages.

All residents of the occupancy were able to self evacuate and there were no injuries to civilians or response personnel.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

The Redwood City Police Department, the California Highway Patrol, the San Mateo County Sheriffs Department and P.G. & E. assisted with the incident.

Prompt and accurate reporting of fires allows the fire department to respond quickly and help protect the citizens of our community.
