SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from the Menlo Park and Belmont-San Carlos Fire Departments responded to a reported structure fire. On arrival units found a shed completely involved in fire that had extended to three vehicles. Due to the efficient work of the members the fire was quickly extinguished with no other vehicles or structures involved. There were no injuries reported as a result of the fire or the extinguishment efforts. The cause of the fire was determined to be accidental.
