SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park Fire D, Woodside Fire, and Foster City Fire responded on a report of a house fire with flames seen and someone calling for help. On arrival fire units found a fire in an upstairs bedroom. Do to the actions of the responding firefighters the fire was contained to the room of origin. A second alarm was called to supplement the units on the scene. No injuries were reported at the time of the fire. There was major damage to the room of origin and moderate damage to the upstairs with some water damage to the first floor.

Other cooperating agencies: Redwood City Police Department, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Peninsula Fire Buffs, Redwood City Fire Department Jr. Fire Academy

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
