SYNOPSIS OF ALARM: Redwood City Fire Fighters along with units from Menlo Park responded to a reported van on fire under the carport of the apartment building. On arrival firefighters found a fully involved van with fire lapping to the floor above. The fire was quickly extinguished and there was no extension of fire to the building. There was moderated damage to the carport and minor smoke damage to the apartment above the fire. There were no injuries reported from the fire and no one was displaced.
