Action Requested or Needed: The Committee will hear comments from members of the public regarding funding for various proposed programs and activities. The Committee is expected to deliberate and by majority vote, will allocate approximately \$675,000 in CDBG funds and approximately \$375,000 in HOME funds. The Committee will agree upon a set of recommendations which will be forwarded to the City Council for their final approval. These funding recommendations constitute an Annual Action Plan to the Consolidated Plan for FY 2009-2010, the Fifth year of the 5-Year Plan.
