Buildings **MUST BE OCCUPIED** and **NOT FOR SALE** during the application or judging process. A remodel or landscape project should be complete upon submitting the application.

Judging: A panel of volunteer judges will prescreen the entries. Final selection will include a tour of the top entries and judging will be completed by the end of July 2006.

Awards: The number of awards given will be at the discretion of the judges. Presentation will be made to award-winning entries at a City Council Meeting to be announced.
