Subject

Disposal of Surplus Property

Recommendation

Adopt a resolution declaring the fire hose inventory referenced herein (Exhibit "A") surplus and convey same to the Fire Science Program at the College of San Mateo in San Mateo.

Background

The fire hose utilized by the Redwood City Fire Department has a service life of ten years. Hose that is beyond its service life and/or is damaged is considered unreliable for emergency operations and is of no value to the City of Redwood City. The hose has significant educational value to the Fire Science Program of the College of San Mateo and can be used for training purposes in both the pre-service and in-service Fire Academies.

In accordance with Section 3-½ of the Charter of the City of Redwood City as amended, the sale of any City personal property having an appraised value of five thousand dollars or less is permitted without public notice or public bid for any reasonable amount, irrespective of its appraised value. It also allows the City to dispose of surplus property no longer required or needed for present or prospective municipal or public purpose without sale.

A total of 46 pieces of equipment may be declared surplus per Exhibit "A", attached hereto.

Alternative

Not approve the transfer of this hose to the College of San Mateo and direct staff to find an alternate recipient or dispose of the surplus property.

Fiscal Impact

The transfer of this surplus property would cause no fiscal impact.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN DESCRIBED CITY-OWNED PROPERTY SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING SALE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City owns that certain personal property listed on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this Council has received evidence that such property is not needed for present or prospective municipal or public purposes, and should be declared surplus; and

WHEREAS, the City Assessor has appraised said property and determined that the current reasonable market value of the total of each of the surplus items to be sold as a unit is less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000); and

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of this Council to declare said property surplus and authorize its sale in accordance with Section 3-1/2 of the Charter of the City of Redwood City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Council hereby finds, determines and declares that those items listed on Exhibit A are surplus; that they are no longer necessary or required for municipal or public purposes; and that the appraised value of the total of each of the items to be sold as a unit is less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).

2. This Council hereby authorizes the sale of the City-owned property described in Exhibit A in accordance with Section 3-1/2 of the Charter of the City of Redwood City.

3. This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.
