Subject

Consultant agreement for closed-circuit television (CCTV) inspection services for the annual Sewer Replacement Project.

Recommendation

By motion, approve the agreement with Pacific Liners of Vacaville, California to provide CCTV inspection services for the annual Sewer Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed \$68,880 and authorize the City Manager to execute same.

Background

The City annually replaces and repairs aging and deficient sections of main sewer line which is funded by the Capital Improvement Program Sewer Fund. Sections for repair and replacement are systematically identified using criteria that include condition of pipe, age of pipe, capacity limitations, and frequency of service disruption. The proposed agreement will provide data required to assess the condition of the sanitary sewers.

Request for proposals (RFPs) were sent to ten selected companies that provide CCTV inspection services. Two proposals were received and evaluated. Pacific Liners was selected based on their qualifications, responsiveness and experience.

Pacific Liners will conduct a closed-circuit television inspection of the sanitary sewer mains which are bordered by Edgewood Road, Whipple Avenue, Alameda De Las Pulgas and El Camino Real. The Contractor will clean the sanitary sewer mains and inspect the pipelines using cameras to record visual data that will be used by staff to assess the condition of each sewer main. Staff will receive data including inspection logs, full streaming videos, and observation codes which classify the condition of the pipe segment. The data will be used to identify sections of the sewer main in need of repair or replacement as part of the annual Sewer Replacement Project.


A copy of the agreement is available for review in the City Clerk's Office.

Fiscal Impact


Funds in the amount of \$927,000.00 are available for the Sewer Collection System Replacement Program in the FY 2006-2007 budget.




