## **SUBJECT**

Amend the Agreement for support of the Redwood City Community Schools for fiscal year 2009/2010

## **RECOMMENDATION**

- 1) Approve the amendment between the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, and the Redwood City School District for support of the Redwood City Community Schools (formerly identified as Redwood City Family Centers) to continue services for fiscal year 2009/2010.
  
- 2) Authorize the City Manager to execute the amendment.

## **BACKGROUND**

Several years ago, the City of Redwood City (City) in partnership with the Redwood City School District (District) and the County of San Mateo (County) agreed to assist the Community Schools with sustainability of the program at Fair Oaks, Hoover, Kennedy and Taft Schools. The Community Schools were established to actively involve Redwood City residents, educators and human services providers in supporting neighborhood children to become successful learners. The Community Schools provide integrated support for children and families, including health services, family support services, parent-community partnerships, adult education, and after-school programs. This program is overseen by the Redwood City School District and supported by Redwood City 2020. The Community Schools reach students and their families in a way that few programs are able to do because they are strategically linked to the school communities they serve.

The City, County, and District are funding the core operations of the Community Schools with \$100,000 from the City, \$113,676 from the County, and \$90,000 from the District for fiscal year 2009/2010.

Additional funds include: \$75,000 from the Grove Foundation; \$75,000 from the Silicon Valley Community Foundation; \$180,000 from the California Department of Education; \$25,000 from the United Way of the Bay Area; and the After School Education and Safety (ASES) and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant.


The agreement between the City, the County and the District is interdependent: if any one of the partners does not enter into the agreement and does not contribute, then the remaining parties could withdraw their contributions. All partners have agreed to continue their contributions for the upcoming year. At this time staff is requesting that Council approve the amendment to the agreement allowing the services to continue for fiscal year 2009/2010. The initial agreement approved on August 25, 2008 included funding for fiscal year 2008/2009, and provided for conceptual approval for fiscal year 2009/2010. Staff is now asking that Council approve the amendment which provides funding for fiscal year 2009/2010.


**ALTERNATIVES**


Council may elect not to authorize the City Manager to execute the amendment.

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO  
THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AND REDWOOD CITY SCHOOL  
DISTRICT (Redwood City Community Schools)**

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE  
July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010**

**I. PAYMENTS**

In full consideration of the term pursuant to the Agreement, and subject to the provisions of funding in paragraph 12.A of the Agreement, payments shall be made upon receipt of District's invoice on or after July 2009, as follows:

- A. County shall pay Redwood City School District one payment of ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$113,676).
- B. City will pay Redwood City School District one payment of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000).
