


Weather Update

We have a forecast for rain this coming Friday, Oct. 14. This will be the first significant rain event this season and residents are advised to take proper safety precautions. We are providing sand bags starting today in the Public Works parking lot located at 1400 Broadway. It will be a self-serve station where Redwood City residents can fill and take up to 24 sandbags. WIDESPREAD RAINFALL FORECAST FOR FRIDAY INTO WEEKEND


Impacts	Forecast Confidence		
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Strong, early season storm set to bring widespread rainfall to the region beginning late Thursday.➤ Moderate to heavy rain, localized ponding, and slick roadways will cause difficult driving conditions.➤ Storm drainages and rain gutters may be clogged by leaves and debris.➤ Strong and gusty winds possible near the coast and in higher elevations early Friday and again late Saturday into Sunday.	 <p>High confidence overall in wet weather pattern. Rainfall totals and timing likely to change.</p>

Thursday Wet weather begins over North Bay late in the day.	Friday Widespread rainfall spreads over the San Francisco Bay Area and Central Coast.	Saturday Lingering showers possible early before 2 nd widespread rainfall event arrives late in the day.	Sunday Showers linger yet widespread precipitation diminishes in coverage.
