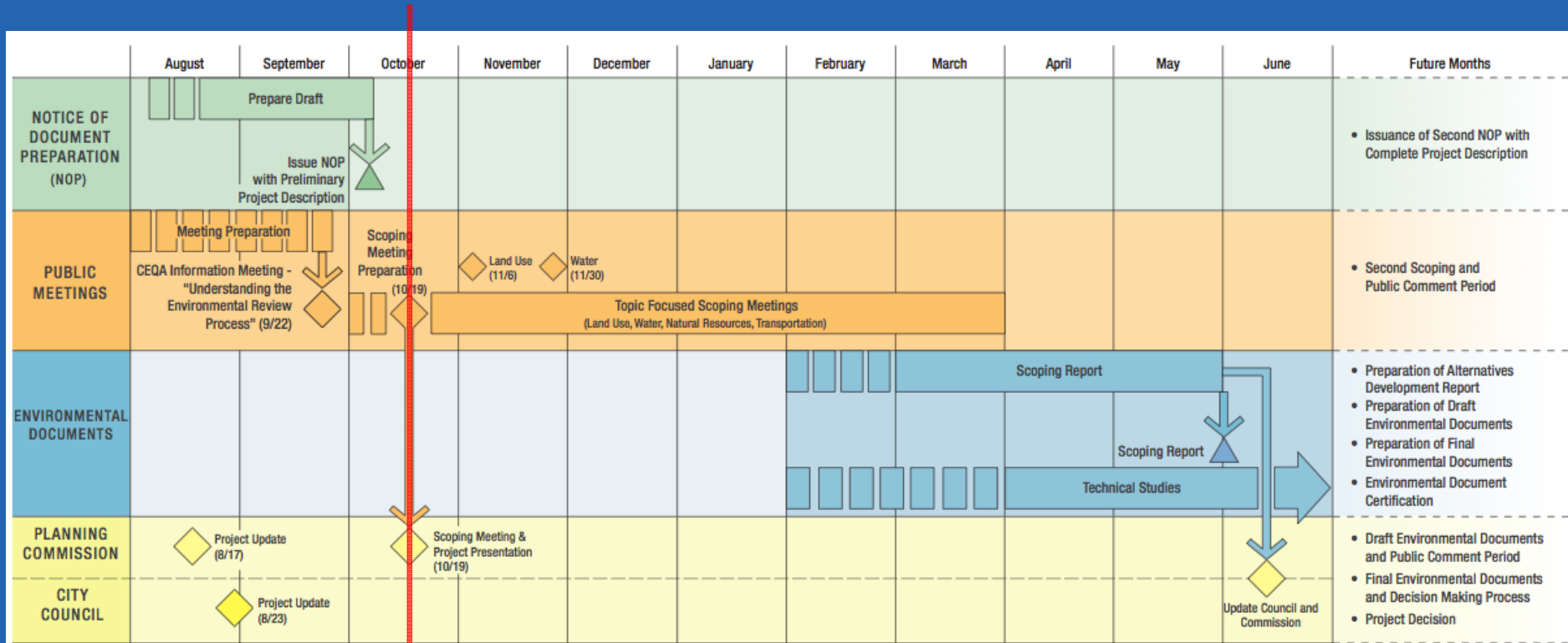

Useful Scoping Input:

- Environmental issues (Impacts)
- Evaluation criteria with thresholds of significance
- Evaluation methodology (Analysis)
- Alternatives to the proposed project
- Mitigation measures
- Existing environmental conditions (Setting)
- Project description

2 – Project Decisions

Topics for Consideration:

- Environmental impacts
- Economic
- Fiscal
- Social
- Project merits

Community Involvement Approach

Participate

Hear and respect all perspectives in an objective process

Be Informed

Provide, and be provided with sufficient and accurate information

Evaluate

Base decisions on full consideration of sufficient and accurate information

Scoping Rules of Conduct

Be Respectful

Be respectful of all comments and positions on the project.

Listen

Listen with the intent of hearing what is said, what is not said, and what the intent/point of the discussion is.

Focus on the Facts

Discussion is to be focused on understanding the facts and understanding the project, City policies, and the process.

~~No Advocacy~~

~~There shall be no debating the merits of the Project or advocating for a position or point of view.~~

Advocacy

We ask that you share your views in a safe and respectful manner, so that all feel comfortable participating.
