INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 08-20-09 approximately 0013 hours Officers responded to the 3500 block of Rolison Road in Redwood City on a report of a subject who was yelling for help and requesting the police. Officers arrived and found the female victim suffering from multiple stab wounds to the upper torso and chest area of her body. The suspect remained on scene and was arrested without incident.

The subsequent investigation determined that the victim and suspect were arguing inside their residence when the suspect grabbed a kitchen knife and stabbed the victim multiple times. Immediately following the assault, the victim went to a neighbor's apartment for help before being transported to the hospital. The suspect was brought to the police department and cooperated with the investigation. He has been booked into jail on the charge of attempted homicide. The victim is undergoing treatment at an area hospital and is in stable condition.
