### INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On February 9, 2009, at approximately 2217 hours, the three above listed suspects approached the victim from behind as he was walking northbound on Winslow Street, near the Redwood City CalTrain station. The three suspects asked the victim if he was affiliated with a gang and the victim said he was not. The suspects then began hitting the victim and stabbing him with a knife.

Officers arrived on scene within two minutes of being dispatched and a citizen pointed out the suspects' flight path. An officer located the three suspects at the intersection of El Camino Real and James Avenue and attempted to detain the three suspects. One suspect assaulted the officer and fled southbound on El Camino Real, while the other two suspects fled back towards the train station. The suspect who assaulted the officer was apprehended by the officer he assaulted; meanwhile, the other two suspects were apprehended by a San Mateo County Deputy Sheriff, north of the original crime scene.

The victim was transported to a local hospital by AMR and treated for serious injuries.
