INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 2-10-09, at approximately 16:39 hours, Redwood City Police responded to 1305 Marshall, an apartment complex, regarding a suspicious package, possibly and explosive. Officers arrived and determined that the package was suspicious and possible contained an explosive device. The area surrounding the apartment was evacuated as a precaution.

The San Mateo County Bomb Squad was contacted and responded to assist. The Bomb Squad examined and detonated the device with specialty equipment. This process caused minor damage to the area where the device was detonated. There were no injuries related to incident.
