Special Seaport Area Pipeline Construction Update

Temporary Closure of Bike/Ped Path Parallel to Highway 101

Bike/Ped Path from Skyway Road to Whipple Avenue

The Bike/Ped path that runs parallel to the east side of Highway 101 between Skyway Road and Whipple Avenue will be temporarily closed at various times between July 21 and August 13, 2008 while the contractor retrofits the existing pipeline. For safety reasons, the Bike/Ped path will be closed entirely to all pedestrian and bicycle traffic for two days, July 21 and July 22, while excavation work is performed.

For the remainder of the construction period, from July 23 to August 13, the

Bike/Ped path will be temporarily closed between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4 PM Monday through Friday. Bicyclists are advised to use an alternate route during the hours the bike path is closed. Industrial Road parallels this section of the bike path and is one option for an alternate route (see map above). Please pass this message on to other cyclists. We apologize for any inconvenience this construction may cause.
