First Year Recycled Water Pipeline Nearly Complete!

Redwood Shores Parkway, Radio Road, Marine Parkway

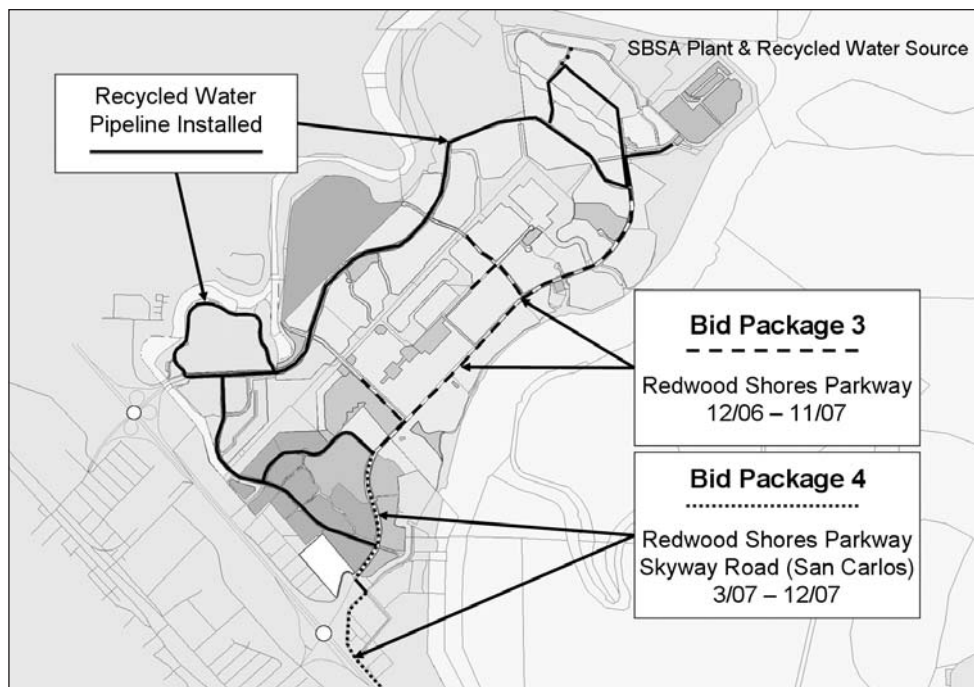
All recycled water pipeline for the first year of construction has been installed, with most of it tested and connected to the existing recycled water line. Final testing, connections and pavement repairs will be done during the month of December, along with any remaining finishing tasks. Paving will likely be more involved on Redwood Shores Parkway and Radio Road, with the possibility of detours. Adequate signage and traffic control will be in place if necessary.

Remaining construction activity will occur between 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM. Traffic flow will be maintained, but there may be minor delays. Look for lane changes with traffic cones and flagmen in the narrower sections.

Some minor preconstruction activity to prepare for construction in 2007 may occur in December, which could include surveying or potholing.

2007 Pipeline Construction

In 2007, the City of Redwood City will be continuing work on its recycled water pipeline system along Redwood Shores Parkway and Skyway Road in the Redwood Shores area. The construction will include trenching in the streets and the installation of pipeline segments on Redwood Shores Parkway between Shearwater Parkway and Airport Way, with some sections of Shell Parkway, Davit Lane, and Bridge Parkway, then continuing along Skyway Road past the airport (San Carlos permit pending).



Bid Packages 3 and 4 will complete pipeline installation along sections of Redwood Shores Parkway, Skyway Road, Shell Parkway, Davit Lane, and Bridge Parkway. Bid Package 3 was awarded to KJ Woods, the same contractor who installed pipe along Twin Dolphin and Marine Parkway.

An informational **Open House** meeting for residents and businesses in the area will be held to introduce project team members, learn details of the schedule and plans, and allow us to answer any questions you may have regarding work in your immediate area or on your routes to schools, shops, and work. The Open House will be held on **Tuesday, January 23, 2007** between **5:30 and 7:30 PM** at the Sandpiper Community Center. A notice will be sent out in advance with meeting details.

Your patience and understanding during construction has been much appreciated, and we will continue to do our best to minimize project-related disruptions during construction.
