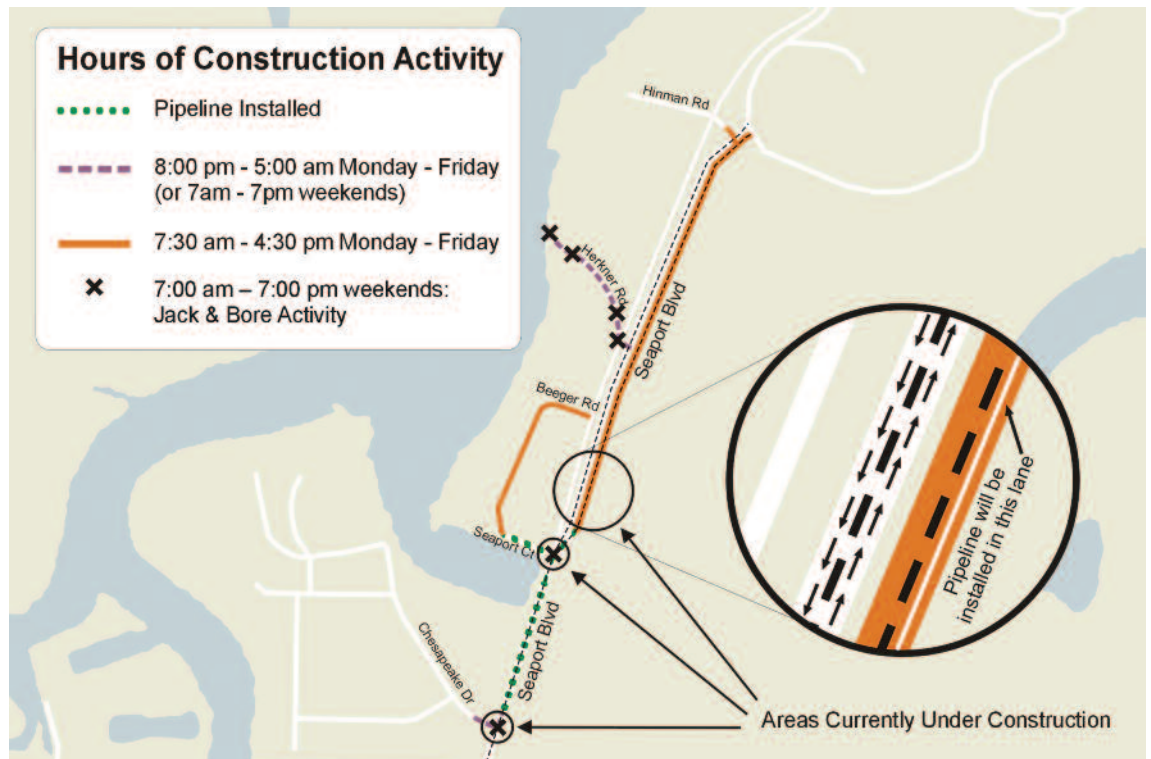

### Seaport Area Pipeline Construction Update

Pipeline construction activity is subject to changes in weather conditions.

### Seaport Blvd north-east of Seaport Court

Pipeline installation is well underway in the Seaport area, during December you can expect to see the Contractor continuing northeast on Seaport Boulevard from Seaport Court. Two way traffic will be maintained in both directions during construction activity as indicated on the map. Work hours are from 7:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.

### Seaport Court

Night and day work will continue at Seaport Court where the pipeline goes under the railroad tracks. Access in and out of the area will be maintained throughout but please watch for flaggers and signage.

### Chesapeake Drive and Seaport

Weekday night work and weekend day work will start this month at the intersection of Chesapeake Drive and Seaport Blvd to jack and bore the pipeline under the railroad tracks. Access onto Chesapeake will be maintained as work crews begin Jack and bore operations near this intersection. Watch for flaggers and signage. Weekend work hours are 7 AM – 7 PM, plus some jack and bore will be performed on weekday nights between 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM to help minimize impacts.

The City of Redwood City would like to thank you for your patience throughout construction of the Recycled Water Project. We are working closely with our contractors to minimize construction impacts. The project team is also working with local and regional fire and medical authorities to ensure that emergency access is not hindered by construction.
