Seaport Area Pipeline Construction Update

Pipeline construction activity is subject to changes in weather conditions.

Seaport Blvd northeast of Seaport Court

The pipeline has been installed in this corridor. An interim road surface repair will be made over previously trenched areas in late January or February depending on the weather.

Seaport Court

The pipeline has been installed in this intersection. An interim road surface repair will be made over the trenched area in late January or February depending on the weather.

Intersection of Chesapeake Drive and Seaport Blvd

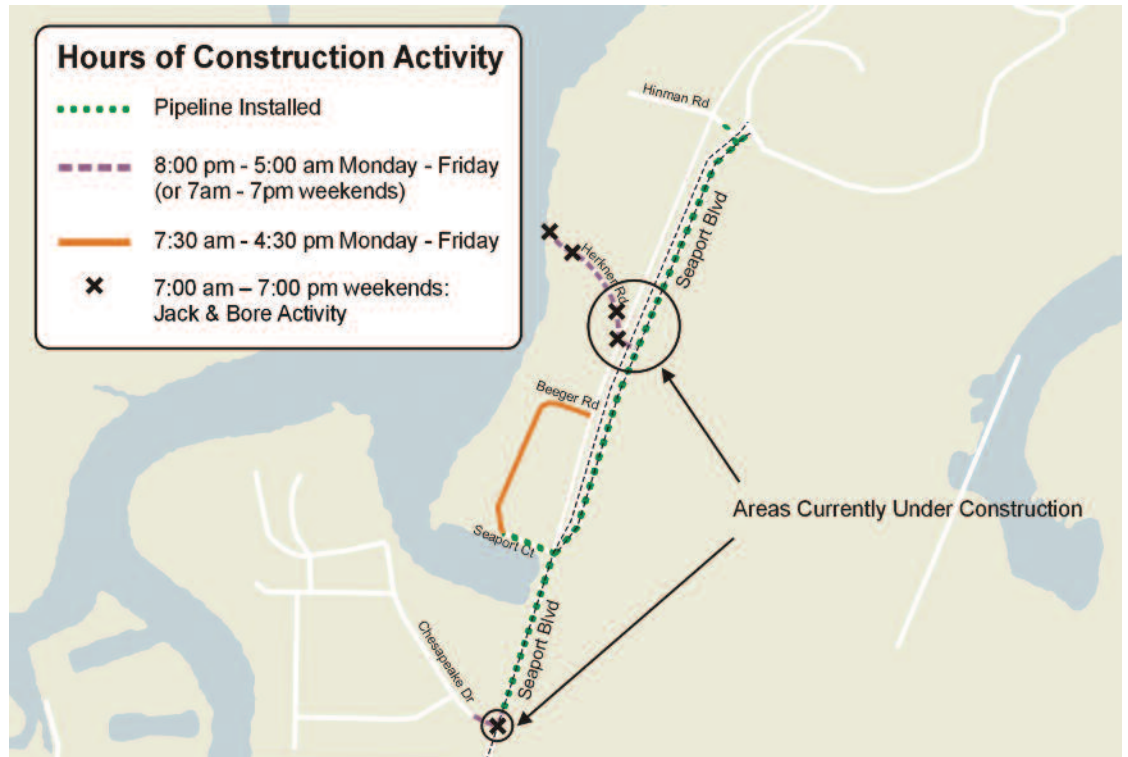
Weekday night work and weekend day work will continue this month at the intersection of Chesapeake Drive and Seaport Blvd to jack and bore the pipeline under the railroad tracks. Access onto Chesapeake will be maintained as work crews begin Jack and bore operations near this intersection. Watch for flaggers and signage. Weekend work hours are 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM, plus some work will be performed on weekday nights between 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM to help minimize impacts.

Intersection of Herkner Road and Seaport Blvd

Weekday night work and weekend day work will continue this month at the intersection of Herkner Road and Seaport Blvd to jack and bore the pipeline under the

railroad tracks. Access onto Herkner Road will be maintained as work crews begin Jack and bore operations near this intersection and the other railroad crossing on Herkner. Weekend work hours are 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM, plus some work will be performed on weekday nights between 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM to help minimize impacts.

The City of Redwood City would like to thank you for your patience throughout construction of the Recycled Water Project. We are working closely with our contractors to minimize construction impacts. The project team is also working with local and regional fire and medical authorities to ensure that emergency access is not hindered by construction.
