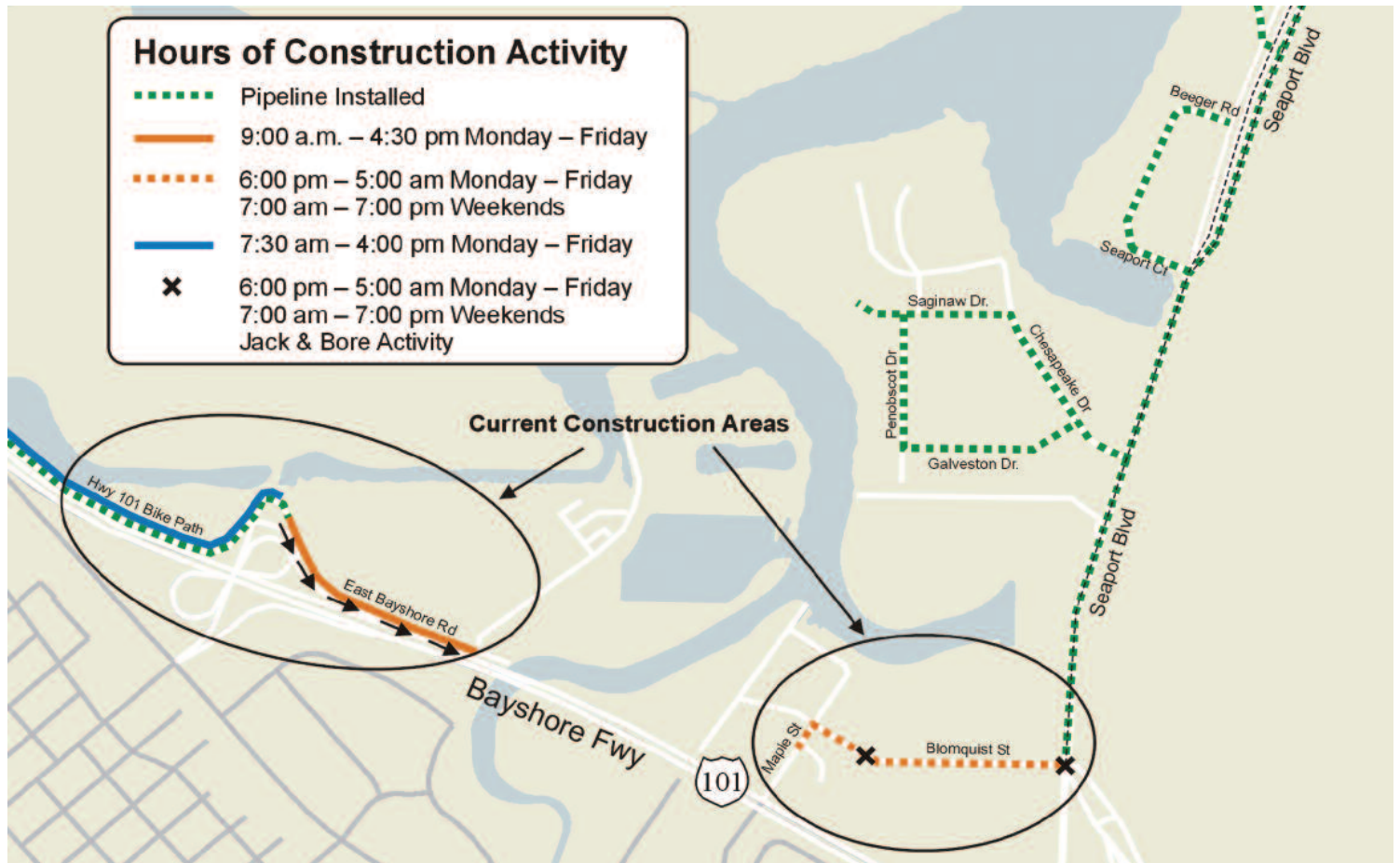

Seaport Area Pipeline Construction Update

East Bayshore Road from Whipple Ave to Bair Island Rd

The contractor will begin pipeline trenching and installation activities on East Bayshore Road at Whipple Avenue and heading southeast toward Bair Island Road. Work will start in late June and access will be maintained in both directions throughout the duration of the project. Construction hours will be from 9 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday.

Highway 101 Bike Path

The contractor will begin retrofitting the existing Highway 101 bike path pipeline between Skyway Road and Whipple Ave. to connect to the new pipeline installed

on East Bayshore Road. Hours of construction will be 7:30 AM to 4 PM Monday through Friday. The contractor will make every effort to maintain access during the construction period but for your safety, it is advised that you avoid the area if possible until construction is complete. Please pass this message on to other cyclists.

Maple Street, Blomquist Street and Seaport Boulevard

The final step in this phase of construction activity will be pipeline trenching and installation on a portion of Maple Street, Blomquist Street and the intersection of Blomquist Street and Seaport Boulevard. Access will be maintained in both directions on all roadways throughout construction. Weekday construction hours will be 6 PM to 5 AM Monday through Friday

and from 7 AM to 7 PM on weekends at the intersection and railroad crossing. Please contact our offices if you have any questions regarding these activities at (650) 743-5759.
