SBSA Construction Update

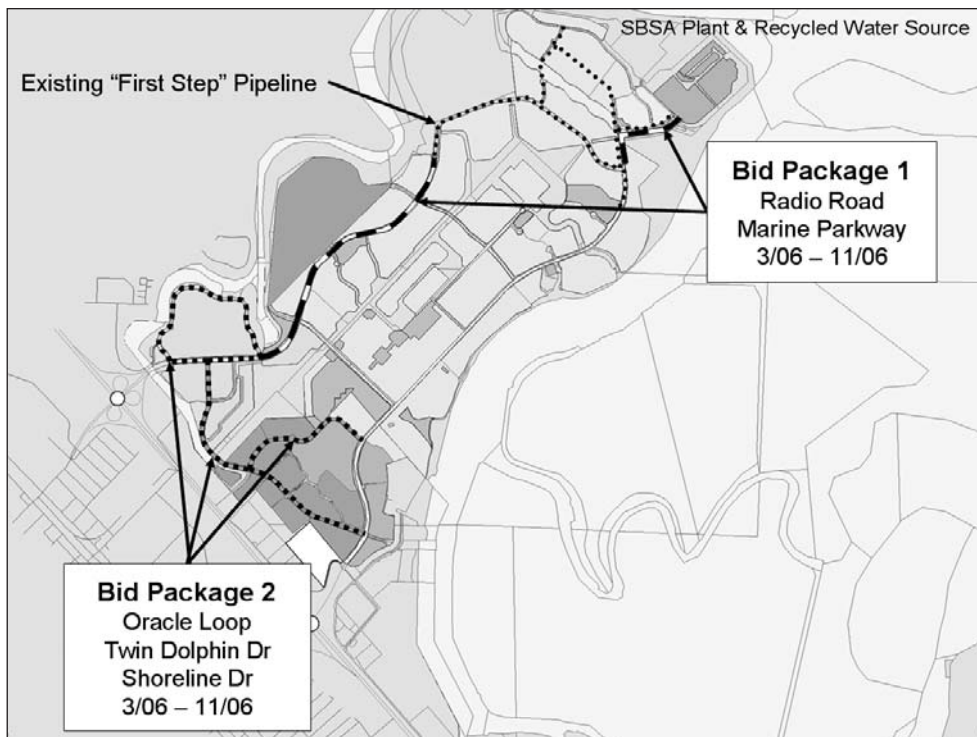
Concrete deliveries will continue to be made on a regular basis. The concrete slab for the floor of the tanks has been poured, and now the walls and tops of the tanks will be the focus until the project's summer/fall completion. Some additional pile driving is expected to occur in early March, but should last no more than one week. Pile driving hours will be between 7:30 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.

Redwood Shores Pipeline Construction

The City is beginning work on its recycled water pipeline system on some streets in the Redwood Shores area. The project is divided into construction packages covering the different pipeline segments. The construction will include trenching in the streets and the installation of pipeline segments on the following roadways: Radio Road, Marine Parkway, Twin Dolphin Drive and Shoreline Drive. See map at right for more detail.

Some pre-construction activities in these segments will be under way shortly, including opening up small areas of pavement to verify the location of buried utilities and videotape existing conditions. Construction is scheduled to begin by the end of March 2006, and be completed in November 2006. Access to businesses and personal driveways will not be impeded. There may be some periodic detours which will be identified by advance mail-out notices.

To ensure this project does not affect neighborhood air quality due to construction related dust or emissions, the City is following stringent mitigation measures for protection of air quality and other environmental concerns as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). These measures are incorporated into project design and specifications, and the City's construction management team will ensure that the project contractors strictly follow these standards.



2006 construction is expected to begin in March and end in November. There will be a few construction crews, completing short sections of the pipeline at a time, moving along the streets shown here.

We have scheduled an informational **Open House** on **Tuesday, March 21, 2006** between 5:30 and 7:30 PM at the Sandpiper Community Center, 797 Redwood Shores Parkway.
