### Redwood Shores Construction Update

#### Radio Road Testing Complete

Final testing has been completed along the north end of Redwood Shores Parkway and Radio Road! Final connections will be made in the next couple weeks, with paving expected to occur (weather dependent) mid-March until complete. Completing this area has taken longer than anticipated and we thank you for your continued cooperation and patience with the road conditions.

#### Bridge Parkway, Davit Lane and Shell Parkway

Bridge Parkway, Davit Lane and Shell Parkway are expected to be paved in the first two weeks of March, likely over a couple hours on two days on each road.

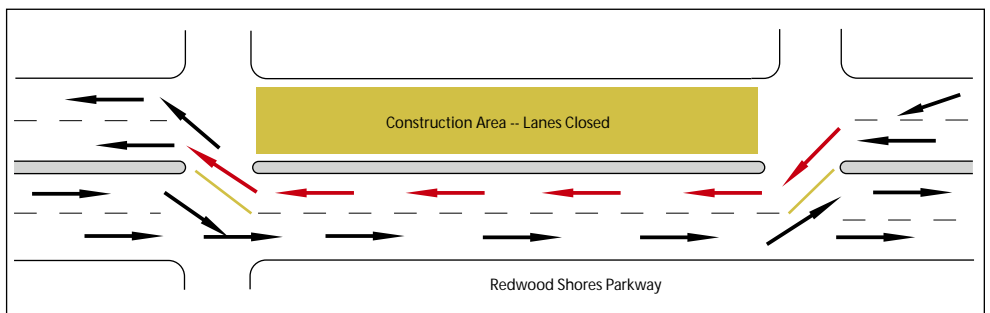
#### Active Pipeline Installation on Redwood Shores Parkway

Redwood Shores Parkway will see pipeline installation well underway during March. Construction began in February just west of the Shoreline Drive intersection and will continue to move east toward Radio Road. The westbound lane will be closed in segments as construction progresses along Redwood Shores Parkway. The westbound traffic will be diverted to the eastbound side. The eastbound side will then support two way traffic, separated by cone delineators and dividers. Signage, and flaggers will be present to ensure safe traffic flow. This traffic control will be very similar to the lane diversion used on Twin Dolphin Drive last summer. Please look for these lane changes and drive extra carefully. Please see the graphic for an example of this lane shift.

For the convenience of those traveling along Redwood Shores Parkway, the construction hours have been moved to

begin at 8:00 AM and will now end at 4:30 PM. Near Sandpiper School and Community Center, construction hours will be 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

#### Bid Package 4 Moving Forward

Bid Package 4, which includes pipeline installation along Skyway Road, is out to

bid (allowing contractors to submit construction estimates). It is anticipated that construction will start in mid-April and will likely begin on the southern end of Skyway Road and then headed in the direction toward the airport.

## Recycled Water Project Site Supervisor Training Workshop

The Redwood City Recycled Water Project will be hosting a Site Supervisor Training Workshop for the future recipients of recycled water. Customer site representatives will be invited to attend this mandatory workshop to learn more about the effective operation and management of a recycled water irrigation system. Property owners and facility managers whose sites are served with recycled water are responsible for their on-site recycled water systems.
