## Recycled Water Project Update

Redwood City Recycled Water Project

### Recycled Water Pipeline Installation Nearly Complete

#### Redwood Shores Parkway and Radio Road

Installation of recycled water pipeline is completed, however, the structures, final testing and connections will continue through part of November along Radio Road near the new SBSA Recycled Water Facility and connecting segments on Redwood Shores Parkway near Shearwater Parkway. Once the pipeline is tested and acceptable, pavement repairs will be made to these roads.

#### Marine Parkway Almost Complete

Main pipeline work on Marine Parkway is completed, however, laterals (smaller piping that connects individual customers to the main line) crossing Marine Parkway, final connections and testing will continue in various locations throughout the month.

Pavement repairs will also be ongoing during November along the eastern part of Marine Parkway, east of Oracle Parkway.

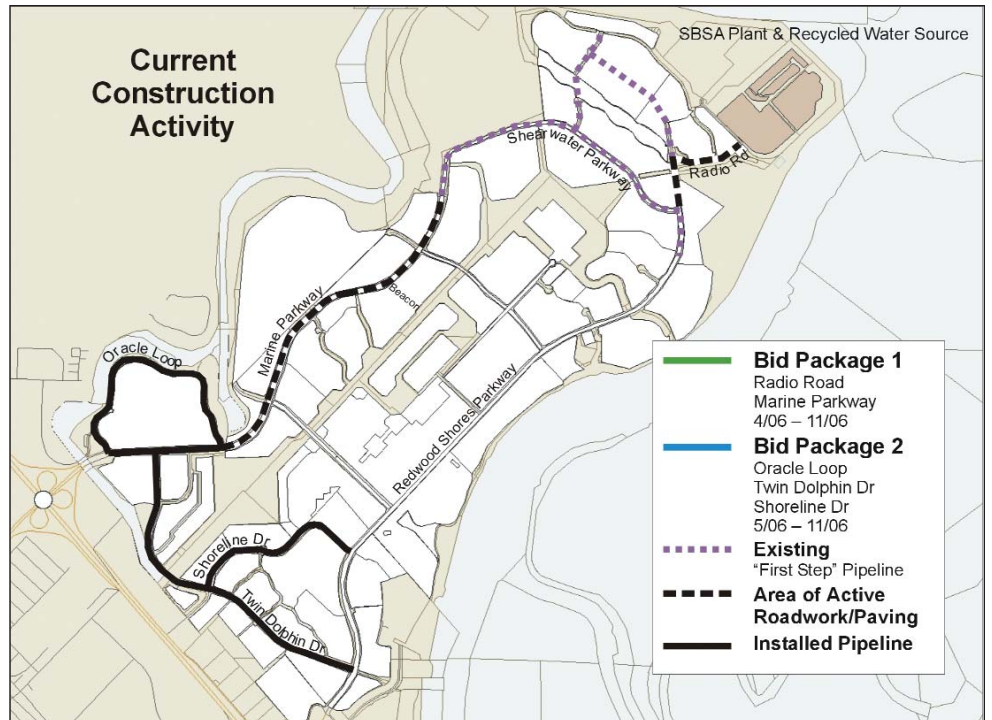
Construction hours will occur between 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM. Traffic flow will be maintained, but there may be minor delays. Look for lane changes with traffic cones and flagmen in the narrower sections.

#### SBSA Treatment Plant Construction Completed

The new recycled water treatment plant structure has been built. November will see exterior site improvements being made, while finishing up miscellaneous items and testing to prepare the system to deliver recycled water to customers in April 2007.

#### Coming Soon

In 2007, the City of Redwood City will be continuing work on its recycled water pipeline system along Redwood Shores Parkway, Bridge Parkway, Shell Parkway, Davit Lane and Skyway Road in the Redwood Shores area.



Pipeline crews are active on Radio Road and Redwood Shores Parkway with smaller crews in other locations. Nearly all of the 27,000 linear feet of the first year pipeline installation has been completed.
