## *Recycled Water Project Update*

Redwood City Recycled Water Project — Seaport Area

### Seaport Area Pipeline Construction is Underway

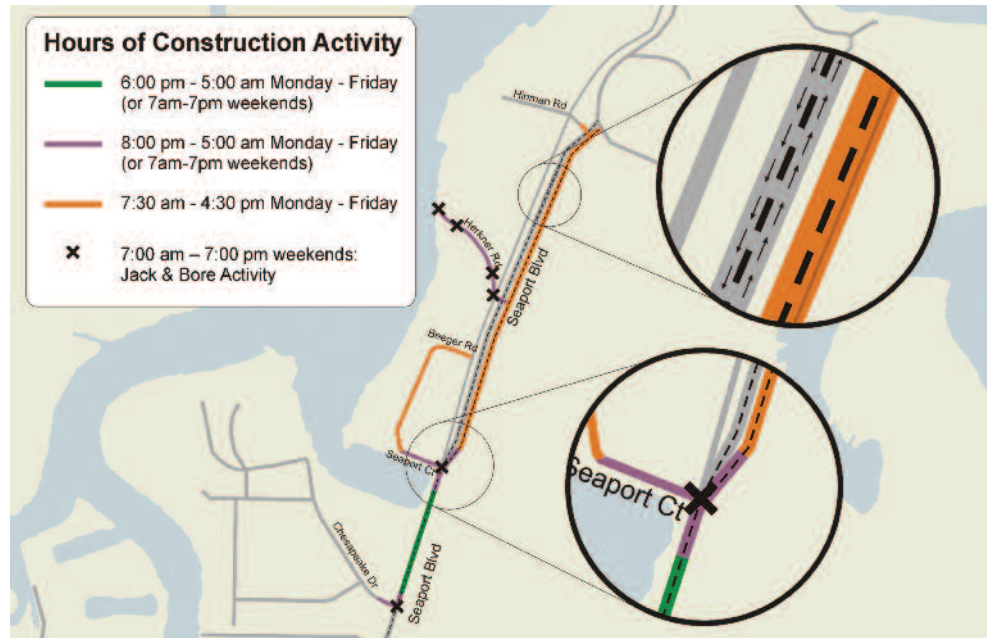
Pipeline installation is well underway in the Seaport area, the Contractor began at the intersection of Seaport Blvd. and Chesapeake Dr., and has been continuing North on Seaport. You may notice temporary paving over previously trenched areas. This work will provide a smoother surface on Seaport but this is not the final paving treatment. After all of the construction is completed, a final road resurfacing and restriping will take place.

Night work will continue on Seaport Blvd. Traffic will be maintained in both directions on the west side of Seaport between Chesapeake and Seaport Ct. This work is necessary to install lateral lines to the curb from our existing pipe alignment. This work is being performed between 6:00 PM and 5:00 AM, Monday – Friday.

Daytime work will also begin on Seaport Ct. the week of November 5, after the nighttime lateral installations are complete. Access into the area will be maintained throughout Seaport Ct., but please watch for flaggers and signage.

### Railroad Crossings

Areas where the pipeline alignment crosses railroad tracks will require drilling underneath the tracks. This type of operation is called Jack & Bore (J&B). The J&B operations require an excavation on each side of the bore; jacking and receiving pits. These excavations will be performed on weekends between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. The J&B of the new pipeline will be performed on weekday nights between 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM to help minimize impacts. At the Herkner Rd. entry point alternative routes will be made available to mitigate disruption to business traffic. These alternative routes will allow traffic flow in both directions. Traffic will also be maintained in both directions at each

railroad crossing where there is a J&B operation.

All construction activity is subject to weather conditions.
