



The City of Redwood City's Master Street Tree List

Our goal for street tree planting is to permit and install the largest appropriate shade tree species, while preserving the maximum park strip spaces available.

➤ **Small Street Trees - (15' to 25' tall at maturity, for 2' to 3' wide park strips)**

- Evergreens:
 - Ilex x altaclarensis 'Wilsonii' – Holly
 - Laurus nobilis 'Saratoga' – Grecian Laurel/Sweet Bay
 - Magnolia grandiflora 'Little Gem'
 - Pittosporum viridiflorum – Cape Pittosporum
- Deciduous:
 - Acer buergerianum – Trident Maple
 - Acer ginnala – Amur Maple/ Tatarian Maple
 - Bauhinia x blakeana – Hong Kong Orchid Tree
 - Cercis canadensis – Eastern Redbud
 - Chitalpa tashkentensis 'Pink Dawn'
 - Crataegus x lavalley (C. carrierei) – Carriere Hawthorn
 - Crataegus viridis – Green Hawthorn
 - Malus floribunda 'Prariefire' – Flowering Crabapple
 - Prunus cerasifera – Cherry Plum/Myrobalan
 - Prunus serrulata 'Kanzan'/'Kwanzan'/'Sekiyama' – Flowering Cherry
 - Prunus sargentii – Flowering Cherry
 - Prunus x yedoensis 'Akebono'/'Daybreak' – Flowering Cherry/Yoshino

➤ **Medium Street Trees - (30' to 45' tall at maturity, for 3' to 5' wide park strips)**

- Evergreens:
 - Maytenus boria – Mayten
 - Pittosporum undulatum – Victorian Box
 - Podocarpus gracilior – Fern Pine
 - Quercus tomentella – Island Oak
 - Quillaja saponaria – Soapbark Tree
 - Tristania laurina – Water Gum
- Deciduous:
 - Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold'/'Saratoga' – Maidenhair Tree (male only)
 - Gleditsia triacanthos – Honey Locust
 - Nyssa sylvatica – Pepperidge/Sour Gum/Tupelo
 - Pistacia chinensis – Chinese pistache
 - Quercus douglasii – Blue Oak
 - Tilia cordata 'Greenspire' – Little-Leaf Linden
 - Ulmus americana 'Frontier' – Frontier Elm
 - Zelkova serrata – Sawleaf Zelkova

➤ **Large Street Trees - (50' and taller at maturity, for 5' and wider park strips)**

- Evergreen:
 - Quercus ilex – Holly Oak/Holm Oak
 - Quercus suber – Cork Oak
 - Quercus virginiana – Southern Live Oak
- Deciduous:
 - Acer rubrum – Red Maple (red fall foliage cultivars)
 - Fraxinus americana 'Autumn Purple' – White Ash
 - Platanus acerifolia 'Columbia' – Plane Tree/Sycamore
 - Quercus coccinea – Scarlet Oak
 - Quercus palustris – Pin Oak
 - Quercus rubra – Red Oak
 - Ulmus americana 'Princeton'/'Valley Forge' – American Elm (DED resistant)
 - Ulmus parvifolia - Chinese Elm/Chinese Evergreen Elm
