CANNABIS REGULATIONS

Summary: The City Council of Redwood City is considering adopting a Zoning Code Amendment to repeal Article 59 (Medical Marijuana Distribution Facilities) and replace with a new Article 59 to bring City regulations into compliance with state law while maintaining local control. Planning Commission recommended approval. The amendments include the following:

- Prohibiting all commercial cannabis activity, including sale, cultivation, distribution, processing, retail, testing, and manufacturing, except for deliveries.
- Permitting personal indoor cultivation of cannabis limited to six plants, in compliance with building and fire codes and state law.

CEQA: The proposed Ordinance is not a project because it has no potential for resulting in physical change in the environment, either directly or ultimately (Section 15378).
