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### MT. CARMEL HISTORICAL STUDY and RESIDENTIAL DESIGN REVIEW

**At this meeting, the City Council will be discussing:**

1. **Mt. Carmel**- Initiating the process to evaluate the Mt. Carmel neighborhood as a historic district. Mt. Carmel is currently bounded by Jefferson, El Camino Real, Whipple and Myrtle. No determination will be made at this meeting.
2. **Historic Review** - Reviewing the process for modifications and demolitions of homes built prior to 1940 throughout the City, including the Mt. Carmel neighborhood.
3. **Residential Design Review** - How current zoning code standards and findings are applied to additions and new construction. At this meeting, City Council could direct staff to evaluate potential changes to these standards and findings.
