

DOCKTOWN MARINA UPDATE

Dear Tenants,

On February 28, the Court of Appeal issued a temporary stay in one of the pending lawsuits challenging the Docketown Plan. That temporary stay prohibited the City from taking any actions to execute the Docketown Plan.

On March 2, 2018, the City requested clarification of the Court of Appeal's temporary stay, asking if the City could provide financial assistance and other benefits to current or former Docketown residents who are relocating from Docketown and wish to receive these benefits.

On March 12, the Court of Appeal granted the City's request for clarification, and confirmed that both the City and tenants who wish to continue the relocation process and receive benefits may now follow through with processing agreements, issuing, and receiving payments.
