ORDINANCE NO 2459

ADOPTED ORDINANCE SUMMARY

Summary: This ordinance amends Chapter 2 (Administration), Article IX (Boards and Commissions) and Chapter 45 (Public Art) of the City of Redwood City Municipal Code to update the powers, duties, and term limits of the Civic Cultural Commission and change its name to the Arts Commission. The ordinance amends the Municipal Code as follows:

- The Civic Cultural Commission name is updated to the Arts Commission throughout the Municipal Code.
- The general objectives of the Commission are updated to reflect the recommendations within Redwood City's Public Art Master Vision.
- The desired skill set and experience of the commissioners are updated and aligned with the composition and qualifications of the commissioners.
- The terms of office are updated to reflect term limits approved by the City Council.
- The definitions of "Programs" and "Works of Art" are updated.
- The section for referral of cultural matters are updated for what the Commission reviews and recommends.
- The officers' titles are updated from chairman to Chair and vice chairman to Vice Chair, and the position of Secretary is eliminated.

These ordinance amendments were introduced on April 22, 2019, and were passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Redwood City, California, on May 6, 2019, by the following vote:
