Location: Citywide

Request for: Public hearing to consider the amendment to Chapters 18 (Local Improvements and Planning), 27A (Stormwater Management and Discharge Control Program), 30 (Subdivisions), and 41 (Floodplain Management). Amendments are proposed to conform to current state laws and federal recommendations, strengthen creek and flood protections, and allow greater lot design flexibility for urban lot splits. Key changes include clarifying underground utility requirements, requiring engineering reports for development near creeks, allowing lot design exceptions for urban lot splits on wide lots, and requiring freeboard in flood zones to match Building Code requirements and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) recommendations.
